In alignment with the recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP), we strongly believe that all children and young adults should receive all vaccines according to the published immunization schedule. This schedule has been carefully designed to provide the best protection at the optimal time for each child.

Families who choose to forgo any of these recommended vaccines will not be able to remain patients in our practice.
